Mrs. Dorothy Margarite Sims Scadden died April 23, 2005 in Huntsville, Texas. Mrs. Scadden was born December 22, 1920 near Beirne, Arkansas to Ernest Miburn Sims and Essie Barbara Nelson Sims.
