Douglas Ray Coleman was born in Huntsville, Texas on November 13, 1959, to Doyle Ray and Velma Coleman. Doug passed away on December 11, 2023.

Doug graduated from Huntsville High School in 1978. Doug was the oldest of he and his sister, Diane. He married Shanda Ainsworth on April 13, 2002, at Northside Baptist Church.
