Eddie Dorrell Edna Mae Shireman Dorrell began her life in heaven on January 27, 2007, at the age of 88. She was born to Lidie Gates and Isaac Wayne Shireman on December 27, 1918 in La Porte, Texas. She was a member of Phelps Methodist Church. She attended Texas State College for Women (now known as TWU) and the University of Texas before graduating from Sam Houston State Teacher's College. She taught first grade for several years in Alta Loma, Texas and in La Porte, Texas. While teaching in Alta Loma, she met and married the agriculture teacher from Santa Fe High School, S. W. Dorrell. They were married for 56 years. They spent the war years in Tacoma, Washington while he was stationed at Fort Lewis. She found a job working in a bank. Returning to Huntsville, they began working the family cattle operation with his father, Seth Dorrell. She began a fulltime occupation as wife and mother. She leaves behind her a legacy of love and kindness. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, S. W., her grandson, Seth Rohe, and two sisters, Jennie Reid and Myrtle Nelson. She is survived by her sister Judy Berry, her daughter, Cindy Rohe and husband Roark, and her grandson, Scott Rohe. Services will be held Monday, January 29, 2007 at 2:00pm at the Phelps Methodist Church with Gary Smithey officiating; interment will follow at the Blackjack Cemetery.
