STEPHEN VINCENT RANDEL, WHOM SHE MET WHILE ATTENDING SAM HOUSTON STATE. EDITH & STEPHEN FAITHFULLY LOVED EACH OTHER THROUGH SEVERAL MOVES INCLUDING TIME SPENT IN PORT ARTHUR, TX, COLUMBIA, MO., AND SCOOPA, MISS., BEFORE RETURNING TO HUNTSVILLE WHERE STEPHEN SUCCEEDED HIS FATHER AS A DEPARTMENT HEAD IN THE SCHOOL OF INDUSTRIAL ARTS AT SHSTC. SHE WAS ALSO PRECEDED IN DEATH BY SISTERS ELOUISE AND DORIS, AND BROTHERS AL, BOB & DAN. SHE IS SURVIVED BY HER
