Edwin Roy Arnold, a longtime Walker County resident took the hand of his wife, Evie Sue and joined her to walk with their Savior on March 20, 2016.

Roy was Veteran of WWII and followed Patton across France, Germany and Belgium. He returned to Walker County where he married his wife, Evie Sue Hardy and moved to Houston for a few years. They returned to Walker County in 1961 and later retired from Reed Roller Bit in Houston and the Texas Forest Service in Conroe to raise cattle for the remainder of his life.

Roy is preceded in death by his father Lee Arnold; mother Viola Stewart Arnold; wife Evie Sue Hardy Arnold; sister Katherine Louise Arnold Cotton; brother Harvey Lee Arnold. He was survived by his brother Willie Ralph Arnold of Rosharon, Texas, who joined him in heaven the following day.

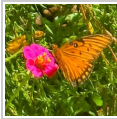
