Born April 18, 1932 in Bremen, Kentucky to parents Louise Neal Donovan and Edgar Allen Donovan, Elizabeth "Ann" Donovan Bass was orphaned at an early age and raised by her aunt Eloise Smith. Ann met the love of her life Hubert "Sam" Bass while living in Kentucky in 1954 married shortly after and moved to Beaumont, Texas where she started her life as a homemaker and wife raising her three children. In 1965 Sam and Ann moved to Huntsville and after her children were out on their own she started a career with the United States Census Bureau that lasted for 21 years.
