Driscoll at the University of Iowa after Barney returned from WWII. They celebrated 65 years of marriage together. Emme worked as a Draftsman during WWII at The Rock Island Arsenal. She also worked as a secretary for many years before serving as a homemaker. Emme is a direct descendent of John Hart, signer of the Declaration of Independence. Emme was also past President of Chapter CO-PEO of Houston, Tx. Emme and her family moved to Huntsville in 1987 after their retirement and was a member and volunteer at the H.E.A.R.T.S Museum in Huntsville, Tx with her husband Barney. Emme is preceded in death by her parents. She is survived by her husband Barney, daughters Carolyn Driscoll Wills, Deborah A. Brown and husband Joe and Jennifer R. Driscoll, son David F.
