February 6, 1925 - February 22, 2014

Gene Glash was born in Pennsylvania February 6, 1925. He grew up in the hills of West Virginia where he earned a football scholarship for college but was sidetracked with his service in the Merchant Marines during World War II. After the war he settled in Houston where he spent the rest of his years dedicated to his family and loved ones. He left us with a legacy of an exemplary life filled with unconditional love for God and others. He was a superb athlete, a hard worker, a lover, a fighter and an amazing father, grandfather, great grandfather, and friend. His words of wisdom and dry sense of humor will be missed in our lives. Gene fell in love with his wife, Sybil Blevins, when he was twelve years old. They were together almost 70 years and gave us one of the world's greatest love stories. She went to Heaven 3 years ago and he has longed to join her ever since that day. He is also preceded in death by his parents, Mickey Glash and Rose Haltom; his sons, Larry and John Kyle Glash; and his granddaughter, Whitney Whitelock. Gene left behind a loving family who adored him: his son, Ron Glash, and wife, Denise; his daughter, Rosie Whitelock, and husband, David; his daughter-in-law, Cathy Glash Pierce, his sister Mary Lee Drozd, and husband Edwin; and many grandchildren and great grandchildren who were proud to call him Grandad.
