Everett Bernard Watson, born July 16, 1934, age 90, died in his home in Montgomery, TX on November 29, 2024 surrounded by his loving wife, daughters and grandchildren. He was a 1956 graduate of Midwestern State University, holding a Bachelor's degree in Mathematics. Mr. Watson became an ordained minister in 1951 by Lamar Avenue Baptist Church in Arlington, TX. Mr. Watson was a United States Army Veteran.
