Flo Corcorran, 98 $\frac{3}{4}$ years old, of Huntsville, Texas went home to be with her Lord and Savior on September 18, 2017. She was born December 2, 1918 in Harris County, Texas to Fred and Martha Hardy.

Flo will be remembered for her strong Christian beliefs. She was a founding member of Market Street Baptist Church of Houston, Texas in 1937 and later became a long-time member of Northside Baptist Church and the Discovery Class at Northside Baptist Church in Huntsville, Texas. She took in many that were in need and gave them shelter and food; and they soon became part of her family.

Flo served as a civilian during the war, maneuvering military trucks carrying ammunition and parking them safely in place.

In 1996, Flo carried the U. S. Olympic torch in the last leg of the run in Livingston, Texas, at the age of 77.

At age 96, Flo's daughters had great concern with her driving, so she went to DPS and took the driving test, which she passed; to prove to them she was still capable of this task.

Flo's strong will and determination throughout her life will live on in all those lives she touched over the years. A special thanks you to each of you, for all

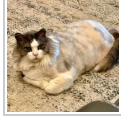
