Frances Mozelle Kerley was born on October 5, 1929 in Petersburg, Texas to Nettie Mae Smith and Zade Kerley. Despite being an only child, she had a large extended family and formed special bonds with her many cousins. She spent her childhood in Kerens before moving to the Klein area where she graduated from Klein High School in 1946. She was a member of First Baptist Church, Recreation Acres and served as church pianist for several years, continuing a family tradition started by her mother and later continued by her daughter.

Frances worked for the U. S. Postal Service for more than 25 years, retiring in 1988. She met her third husband Robert Roesse while working at the post office and they were married on November 22, 1972. After retiring, they moved to Washington, Texas to live and work on his family farm. She joined Frieden's United Church of Christ at that time. She and Robert celebrated their 25th wedding anniversary shortly before his passing.

Known affectionately as Granny to not only her grandchildren but also their friends. The farm was a frequent weekend gathering place. On those rare occasions when she wasn't hosting visitors, she loved to travel with her family and friends.
