Francis Allen Hoffer, 74, passed away on April 12, 2022, in Willis Texas

Allen Hoffer was born on June 29, 1947 in Kingsville, TX, to Francis Antone Hoffer and Elza Clementine Hoffer.

Allen graduated from Harlingen High School and went on to earn a degree from Delmar Tech. After school, Allen was drafted into the U.S. Army and served in the Vietnam War. Post discharge, Allen began his career as a mechanic. Ultimately, he found his calling as a Property Manager (Ranger) for the San Jacinto Girl Scouts for 27 years.
