



Frederic Elwood Hensey

Frederic "Fred" Elwood Hensey, born in Taylorville, IL in 1939, passed away in Conroe, TX on December 1st, 2017 after a long battle with Pneumonia. He was preceded in death by his spouse of 29 years, Sudie "Sue" Ann (Melton) Hensey, January 18, 2015.

Son of John L. Hensey and Annalou (McGuire) Hensey. Fred was a resident of Elkins Lake in Huntsville, TX. 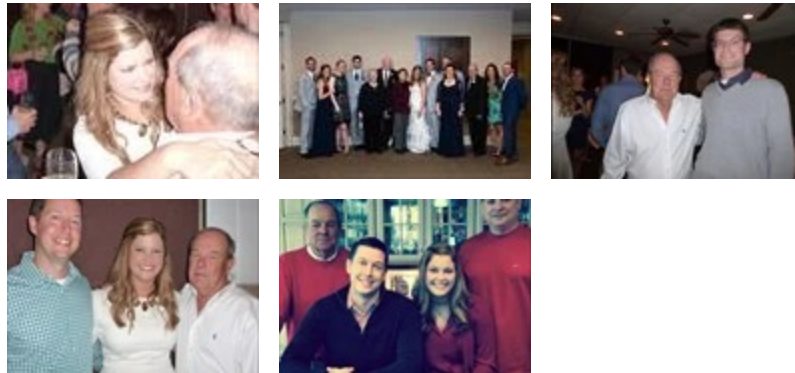
