Gary "B" Ashe Gary "B" Ashe, Ph.D. Physical Biochemist went home to be with our Lord, June 5, 2006. He was born November 18, 1943 in Baytown, Texas to Fred B. and Mary Ella Ashe. He was preceded in death by his Loving Mother, Mary Ella Shelly; Stepfather, James Milton Shelly; and Beloved Grand Parents, G. B. Cotton and Joanadelia Cotton who helped to make him the wonderful man he became. The beloved husband and father is survived by his wife, Michol Charlotte Ashe; son, David Austin Ashe of El Paso, Texas; his loving sisters Alpha Lee Davis of Dallas, Texas; Lynda Gayle Blair and brother-in-law Bobby Blair of Huntsville, Texas. He will also be greatly missed by a number of nieces and nephews. Gary Ashe graduated from Huntsville High School and Sam Houston State University. He received his Doctorate in Physical Biochemistry from Brown University in Providence, R.I. He was a Professor of Chemistry at the University of Texas at El Paso and later became a businessman contributing to the El Paso Community. He was a member of Delta Tau Delta and was voted most likely to succeed by his fellow classmates. He was nominated for the Piper Professor Award by his university students for being a most revered professor. Dr. Ashe was also made an Honorary Eagle Scout by Troop Four Scout Master, Sam Snoddy, for his contributions to Scouting and for his honesty, integrity, and intellectual creativity. Pallbearers will be former classmates and Delta Tau Delta fraternity brothers. Visitation will be held at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home on Thursday, June 8th from 5 -7 PM and Services will be held Friday June 9th at
