She was a devoted Wife, Mother, Grandmother and Great Grandmother. Jane is preceded in death by her parents, Vernon (Bill) and Bessie Guthrie; sister, Francis Strickland; and brother, J.B. Howell. She is survived by husband, David G. Moorman; daughter, Leigh Ann Dye and husband Alan; son, David W. A firm believer in education, Jane was an elementary teacher in Lubbock and College Station and taught in the Windham school system in Huntsville. As a teacher, Jane saw what students could accomplish. She taught the ultimate “at-risk” students – incarcerated men, with patience and skill. Jane communicated a sense of values to the students and an appreciation for life-long learning. Jane loved traveling, assisting with the Walker County Fair, returning to her parent’s farm and enjoying the out-of-doors.
