



Glenn Alan Brunson

February 11, 1944 - January 17, 2018

Surrounded by family, Glenn Alan Brunson passed away peacefully in his home on January 17, 2018 in Richards, Texas.

Glenn was born on February 11, 1944 in Ballinger, Texas to Aubrey and Azell Brunson. He graduated from Ballinger High School and attended Texas Tech University in Lubbock, where he met and married the love of his life, Jolene McGinnis on November 2nd, 1963. Though he worked in numerous locations around the world, he lived in Midland, Texas for the majority of his life. He retired as a measurement specialist from Mobil Pipeline Company. The remainder of his years were spent entertaining grandchildren, building and riding trike motorcycles, consulting, pursuing home projects, and teaching tricks to Chumley, the wonder dog.

Glenn loved golfing with his buddies, talking football and cheering on the Cowboys, and working on projects with his brothers. He enjoyed opening his home to others, especially to his grandchildren's friends, who knew him as "Papaw" and often stopped by for a meal or a game on TV. He was gifted with the ability to find humor in everything and was always quick with a joke or trick up his sleeve. With his infectious, beaming smile, Glenn would do anything for a laugh - even have his hair put up in bows and his nails painted by his nieces, all before a company picnic. He'd go to any length to save a dollar, even if it meant successfully redeeming counterfeit coupons at the local donut

store. He was a giant man with a heart of gold. Anyone who crossed his path was undoubtedly left with a smile or a laugh.

He was preceded in death by his parents; brothers, Lanny and Stephen; and brother-in-law, Dick Reeder.

Glenn is survived by his wife, Jolene, and two children, Tracy and Amy. He is also survived by six grandchildren; Jared and wife Georgia, Garrett, Caleb, Josh Hopkins, Ryan Hopkins, and Jaclyn Hopkins; and two great grandchildren, Jersey Hopkins and Lucas Wilson.
