Glenn Edward Ehlers, born September 1st, 1947 in Islip, New York, passed away on May 10th, 2023 in Conroe, Texas. As a child, he was an active FFA member along with Boy Scouts of America. He received 3 Grand Champion Ribbons for poultry in high school and received the State of Florida Grand Championship Poultry Award. He also was a young entrepreneur and had an egg route that he would go door to door selling eggs on his scooter. After graduating high school in Zepherhills, FL, he enlisted in the United States Army and was a very PROUD Vietnam Veteran. You would rarely see him around town without his Vietnam Veteran hat on and was proudly wearing it upon his passing. He ended up taking advantage of the GI Bill and graduated from the University of South Florida.
