even a few well known musicians such as Elvis Presley, Ernest Tubbs and Frenchie Burke.

Glynn took great pride in being known as the mentor of Old Houston Road where he spent most of his evenings on the front porch surrounded by many telling tall tales and offering solutions to the worlds problems. He was very close with his family helping them through both good times and hard times, knowing when to laugh and when to listen. He leaves a legacy of friendship, loyalty, generosity and laughter. 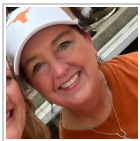

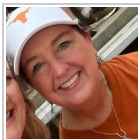
