Gwyneth (Gwyn) Elaine Ener Gore was born in Jasper, on May 27, 1934, to Ernest and Bessie Mae Ener, the 5th of 8 children. Gwyn was working for the phone company in Silsbee when she met Tracy, the love of her life. She knew that he was “the one” when her daughter Frances began following him around like a puppy dog at age 5. Gwyn convinced Tracy to move to Huntsville where there were greater job opportunities and they lived happily married for 52 years.

Gwyn remained a resident of Huntsville following Tracy’s passing until 8 years ago where she relocated to Flower Mound, Texas to be closer to her daughter. She passed away on August 7, 2021, at age of 87.
