



H. Rolando Leguizamon

H. Rolando Leguizamon was born more than 84 years ago in Buenos Aires, Argentina. His parents are Dr. Guillermo E. Leguizamon and Irene de del Pino. He is preceded in death by his parents and his stepfather, Luis de del Pino. He attended the Liceo Militar San Martin. Later, he graduated from the Colegio Manuel Belgrano. During rather turbulent years in Argentina, he entered the University of Buenos Aires Law School and his study career was interrupted when the school was closed. In 1955, he immigrated to Sao Paulo, Brazil where he stayed for eight years. In Sao Paulo, he founded "El Circulo Argentina" and was its first secretario. He then immigrated to the United States in August 1963 and started a career with John Hancock Life Insurance Company as a registered representative. In his first year, he led the agency and won the Houston Achievement Award. In 1968, he joined Occidental of California as a general agent. In 1975, he received his CLU distinction (Charter Life Underwriter). He had a long career in insurance and financial counseling with Transamerica Financial Services. He was a founding member of the Casa Argentina de Houston where he served at every level of this organization for many years. He was president in 1973 and 1975. In 1969, he became a member of the Institute of Hispanic Culture and was a strong participant in the development of this Institute for many years. He was president in 1985 and chairman of the board in 1986. Rolando is survived by his beloved wife, Hildegard, his son, Rolly (wife Lee Anna), his only grandchild, Levi and his daughter, Jackie. He is also survived by siblings, Aida
