



Harold Dodd

October 14, 1934 - February 20, 2007

Harold Dodd, devoted husband, loving father, and valued friend passed away peacefully on February 17, 2007 after a long battle with cancer. A 1956 graduate of Baylor University with a BBA in Finance, Dodd began his banking career in Waco. He then served as bank examiner for 7 years with the Federal Reserve Board. In 1964 Dodd resumed his commercial banking career in the Dallas-Fort Worth area. He was Senior Vice President and Director of Inwood Bank in Dallas. In 1973 he moved to Fort Bend as President and CEO of then First National Bank of Stafford. He was named Chairman and CEO in 1980 when the bank was sold to Texas Commerce Bankshares and became Texas Commerce Bank-Stafford. In 1985 Dodd was elected Chairman of the Board and CEO of Bellfort National Bank. Dodd was instrumental in starting the Fort Bend Chamber of Commerce and also served as its President and Director. He also is Past-President of the Sugar Creek Country Club and Chairman of the Board of First Colony Levee Improvement District No. 2. In 1991 the Dodd family moved to Huntsville, Texas. He joined Trinity Steel Fabricators, Inc. and served as Vice-President and later as President. He enjoyed working in the yard, taking walks, vacationing with family, and spending time with friends and loved ones. Harold Dodd was born October 14, 1934 in Waco, Texas, and is preceded in death by his parents Harry and Myrtle Calvert Dodd. He is survived by his wife of 35 years, Muriel Dodd of Huntsville, two sons, Michael Dodd and wife Kimberly of Portland, Oregon, and David Dodd of West Palm, Florida. Also surviving are one sister Helen Hawkins of Winter Springs,

Florida, one brother Jim Bob Dodd and wife, Delphine of Houston, Texas, and one sister-in-law Sandra Parent of Vancouver, Canada. Additional survivors include aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins, and other cherished family members. Visitation will be held Monday, February 19, 2007, 5-7PM at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home in Huntsville, TX. Funeral services for Harold Dodd will be Tuesday, February 20, 2007 at 2:00PM in Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Chapel with Rev. Mark Pickett officiating. Interment will be Wednesday, February 21, 2007 at 1:00PM in Rosemound Cemetery, Waco, Texas.
