



Harold Leon Harris

May 4, 1930 - July 22, 2025

Harold Leon Harris passed away on July 22, 2025 in Montgomery, Texas at the age of 95. Harold was born on May 4, 1930 in Crandall, Texas and grew up in the Dallas area where he finished his education majoring in Architecture and Aeronautics and minored in Mechanical Engineering. He began his energy related career with Burgess Manning, then took a position with T.F. Hudgins Company. Later he became regional sales manager for C.E. Miller Co. In 1977 Harold formed Harris International Sales Corp. {HISCORP) and became a manufacturers representative in the gas compression industry and engaged in the design and manufacture of air pollution control equipment and noise reduction equipment for internal combustion engines. In 1980 Harold developed and patented the DeNox Silencer Combination Catalytic Converter Silencer for use with natural gas engines and diesel engines worldwide under the dba of Houston Industrial Silencing and later HIS Emissions Reduction Systems. In 2002 the company was sold and Harold and his wife and business partner retired.

Harold is survived by his wife of 45 years, Linda Harris, daughter Lisa Barrett, daughter Denise Anguish and son in law John Anguish, son Brian Harris, grandchildren Nicholas Barrett, Brooke Looney and husband P.J. Looney, Hannah Harris and great grandchildren Kylie and Presley Looney, and Harper Stout. He was preceded in death by his mother Lela Oliver Fuller, daughter Lori Dyer and son Timothy Harris.

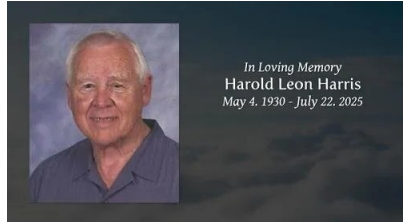
