Henry Quannah "Hank" Adams December 7, 1934- East Texas December 1, 2022-Springtown, TX

Quannah Adams, who was also affectionately known as Hank, Pop Hank and PaPa Hank, passed into Heavenly glory Thursday morning, December 1, 2022. He was just six days shy of his 88th birthday, which would have been Dec 7th, 2022.

He graduated Huntsville High School in 1953 and then joined the Air Force where he served 28 years. Hank was a tail gunner on a B52 for most of his military career until retiring to Missouri in 1979, where he was finally able to do what he dreamed of, raising beef cattle and hay. They lived in Gainesville Missouri where they were very active in their church and community. But when his wife, told him she missed her kids and was moving back to Texas in 1997, with or without him, he decided it was a good idea to come with her. They settled in Lovelady and started raising beef cattle and hay again. As in Missouri, they were equally active in their church and community. Hank was a Mason for over 65 years and a staunch Conservative.
