



## Jack Roland Clements

March 30, 1927 - June 10, 2018

Jack Roland Clements was born March 30, 1927 in Jeff Davis Hospital in Houston, Texas to Clara Davis Clements and Jack Clements of Weldon, Texas. He lost his mother, Clara at a very young age.

After his mother's death, he was reared by his maternal Grandmother, Ida Doan and her husband "Cousin Dick" Doan, while his father went to work out of town to support the family. He attended school in Weldon, Texas and joined the US Navy prior to graduation. After a tour of 2 years, in which he saw World War II Combat, he was discharged in 1946 as a Fireman 1st Class (PO1). He completed study to receive a High School Diploma.

He married Carol Marie Phillips June 29, 1950. The two children born to them were Charlotte Marie Clements in 1951 and Richard Alan Clements in 1956. They resided in Houston Texas until the late 1990's when they moved to Huntsville, Texas.

In his early adult years, his chosen profession was sales in various forms where he received recognition for outstanding performance. Sears Roebuck and Kaplans Ben-Hur were among the companies from which he achieved recognition. In his fifties, he became a Landlord and a Business Owner of a Small Engine Repair Company and sold Utility Trailers at the same time. He sold the business and property in Houston and upon moving to Huntsville he

began Forest Hills Lawn Mower Repair. He continued in this business until his retirement.

His retirement years were spent tinkering around the house, and enjoying camping, his family, and his grandchildren.

He passed into the presence of his Lord on June 10, 2018 and was preceded in death by his siblings, A.D. Clements, Myrtle Louise Herolz, and Marjorie Favela. He is survived by his wife, Carol Clements; his daughter, Charlotte Miller; his son, Richard Clements and wife, Dora; his Grandchildren, Anne Bittinger and husband, Justin; Christopher Miller and wife, Brooke; Chris Becerra and wife, Yvonne; and Corinne Clements; numerous Great-Grandchildren, as well as numerous Nieces, Nephews and Cousins.
