



Jack Strange, Sr.

April 5, 1919 - January 1, 1753

Longtime resident of Texas City, Jack Strange, Sr., passed away peacefully while surrounded by family on Feb. 12 at the age of 92. Born April 5, 1919, Jack worked, lived, volunteered, and raised his family in Texas City for over 60 years. Though not born in Texas City, he always considered Texas City his home. Jack was preceded in death by loving wife Berniece after 65+ years of marriage and by an infant daughter Jackie. He is survived by Marcia Rausch and husband Leon of Conroe, Dorothy Zavitz and husband Steve of Spring, and Jack Strange, Jr. and wife Beth of Huntsville. Also, 9 grand-children and a host of great-grand-children carry on his legacy. Jack never met a stranger, and he always had a smile and kind word to pass on to everyone that crossed his path.
