Jack P. Strange, Jr. Longtime resident of Texas City and recent retiree of Huntsville, Jack Strange, Jr., passed away peacefully while surrounded by his family on July 17, 2012 at the age of 63. Born October 16, 1948, Jack worked, lived, volunteered, and raised his family in Texas City. Jack is preceded in death by his parents, Jack, Sr. and Berniece. He is survived by Beth, his loving wife of 33 years; two daughters, Kristi Strange, Jeanne Sharp and husband Travis; granddaughter Audrey Sharp; and sisters, Marcia Rausch and husband Leon, Dorothy Zavitz and husband Steve; also, numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and friends. After graduating with a degree in engineering from Texas Tech University, Jack went on to work for the Texas Department of Corrections becoming an assistant warden before finishing his career at Amoco/BP in Texas City. Jack was a shining example of God's love as reflected in the way he lived his life sharing it through music and ministry. He was a true outdoorsman, enjoying his free time hunting, fishing and golfing. He was a "Jack-of-all-trades"!
