James Curtis Davis passed away, surrounded by family, on Saturday, September 21, 2019 at age 70, after succumbing to pneumonia. He was born on May 12, 1949 in Cameron, TX to James W. and Marie Maddox Davis. He graduated from Cameron HS in 1967 and enrolled in Blinn Jr. College before transferring to Texas A&M. Following his graduation in 1967 with a B.S. in Agricultural Education, he enlisted in, and proudly served, in the United States Army Reserve until 1983. Through several job changes, he moved to Huntsville and continued his education at Sam Houston State University, graduating with a Masters of Education in 1975.
