Janet Kay Wade Miller, 71, passed away peacefully on May 8th, 2023 at MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston, TX after a hard-fought battle with Myelodysplastic Syndrome which led to Acute Leukemia. A memorial service will be held Thursday May 11th, 2023 at 2:00pm at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home in Huntsville, TX.

Janet was born on June 4, 1951 in Honolulu, Hawaii; the daughter of Harlan and Sue Wade. After graduating from Sam Houston State University in 1975, Janet worked for the Texas Department of Criminal Justice for 20 years.
