



Jason Peter Njaa

October 17, 1938 - July 31, 2018

Jason Peter Njaa, 79, from Huntsville, went home to the Lord on July 31, 2018. His celebration of life service will be held at 3pm on Saturday, September 8, 2018 at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home.

Jason was born in Valley City, North Dakota and raised on the family farm. He and his family moved to Spokane, Washington, where he graduated high school. At the age of 11, he was introduced to the game of golf as a caddy and quickly learned to play. He made the varsity golf team as one of its youngest members as a freshman in high school and lettered for three years. After high school, Jason attended North Park College in Chicago where he graduated in 4 years with a degree in mathematics. While at North Park, Jason met Ginger Kent who would be the love of his life and his wife for the next 60 years.

Before his senior year, he married Ginger, and they lived together in Chicago while he finished his degree. They went to Spokane, WA and celebrated the birth of their first son, Kent. After graduation, Jason and the family moved to Santa Monica, CA, where he worked for a private company doing computer programming for the military. He was transferred to Battle Creek, Michigan where they welcomed their second son, Scott. They then moved to Germany for 18 months to assist in programming the military defense systems, and then returned to the states and settled in Norwood, Massachusetts. This is where

they welcomed their third son, Adam. Jason joined Foxboro as a systems analyst and programmer, with a career that would take him on trips all around the world.

While in Norwood, Jason and Ginger attended the Covenant Congregational Church in Boston. Jason was active in the church singing every week in the choir and regularly participating in the Christmas concerts as a soloist. In 1976, the family moved to Houston, TX where Jason and Ginger finished raising their sons. Jason and the family attended John Knox Presbyterian Church where he resumed his duties as a choir member and joined the yard mowing crew. Jason and Ginger joined Inwood Forest Golf Club where they would spend many fond weekends with friends and enjoying the great outdoors.

Jason and Ginger chose to retire and move to Elkins Lake, Huntsville, TX in 2006. There, they were very active members of the club, helping to coordinate the couple's golf tournaments, and joined a group that took routine trips to distant and interesting golf courses. Jason played golf with his friends 4 to 5 days a week, and volunteered around the golf course to help with clean up.

Jason has been a calm foundation for his family, teaching his children patience, wisdom and practicality. His compassion and caring for his dear wife taught his boys how to care.

Jason was a friend to many, and enjoyed a great game of golf and a wonderful meal with many. His presence will be missed.

He is preceded in death by his loving wife Ginger Njaa, his parents, Paul and Anne (Person) Njaa, and his brother Donald Njaa. He is survived by his brother, Paul Njaa and wife Sandy, his sister-in-law Terri Njaa, and his three sons and their wives – Kent Njaa, Scott and Lynn Njaa, and Adam and Laura

Njaa. He also leaves 5 grandchildren and 3 step grandchildren.
