Jerre Ann Cranford Pierce was born in Conroe Texas to William Lafayette Cranford and Emily Blanche Pierce Cranford on August 7, 1939. She went home to be with the Lord and O.B. on December 8, 2017. The youngest of four kids, Jerre grew up and lived all her life in Conroe. She graduated from Conroe High School in 1957 with honors, attended North Texas Women's University in Denton Texas but graduated from Sam Houston State Teachers College, Huntsville Texas in 1961 with a major in Spanish and a minor in Music. Jerre loved music, all music. She was a concert pianist and played many performances in her younger years for various community events. She loved animals, riding horses, and spending time with her family. Life would be changed forever during the SHSTC (SHSU) Homecoming parade in Huntsville in 1960 when Jerre would meet the love of her life. While walking through the college parking lot, a good looking fella in a red and black Ford SunLiner convertible drove up looking for a parking spot and the rest is history. Jerre married O.B. Pierce at her parent's home in Conroe on March 2, 1962. They spent 47 years together until O.B.'s passing in 2009. Jerre worked in the oil patch for many years for Getty Oil Company, Superior Oil Company and finally retiring from Mobil Oil Company in 1985. It was then that their life together got very busy. Jerre became O.B.'s right hand in the cattle business. They spent many days building and fixing fence, tending and feeding cows, hauling hay and much more. She loved every minute of it. Her love for her family and her animals never waivered. Jerre had a spark-plug personality, was loads of fun
