Jerry Lee Brigance, aged 88, passed away on November 20, 2022. He is survived by daughter Lee Pappas and husband Nick; granddaughter Zoe Pappas; Sister Thelma Fuller; Niece Kelly Fuller; and other friends and relatives. Jerry was preceded in death by his parents, and his wife, Ruby, in 2009. Jerry was born in Parma, Missouri, and raised in Flint, Michigan. He was a great patriot and a Cold War veteran. He joined the United States Air Force, where he served for 21 years as staff sergeant and cryptographer.
