Jerry Claude Davis passed away August 21, 2021 in Houston Texas. He was born June 30, 1972 to Jerry Howell Davis and Joyce Mary Davis in Asheville, North Carolina.

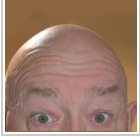
