Jerry Sue passed away on September 12, 2017, preceded in death by her parents, Edgar and Dorothy Fisher Hendrick. She is survived by her loving husband Peter Troy Henry, their children Heather Henry Kenney and husband Stephen, and Hunter Troy Ray Henry; sisters Julia Hobbs Kinni and husband Mark, and Janet Hendrick McArdle and husband Tom, along with many adoring nieces and nephews as well as great nieces and nephews.

After graduating from Texas City High School in 1976, Jerry studied at community college and the University of North Texas in Denton. As a resident of Huntsville for many years, she was active in numerous parent organizations, worked at Sam Houston University and Bayes Achievement Center. She was a member of the Daughters of the Republic of Texas, participating with her sisters and late mother Dorothy.

In 1993 Jerry married the love of her life, Peter Henry. Pete was her rock, whom she admired, respected, loved, and adored. She longed to be a mother and thought Heather was the cutest little girl ever and felt giving birth to her baby boy, Hunter, was truly the highlight of her life. She brought her talents for baking, sewing, and crafting to Hunter's many activities and traveled around the country and abroad for Boy Scout trips, the German Club and mountain-

biking. She willingly offered her time and her warm heart as well as her prayers for any endeavor in which Hunter participated, often being seen blasting around Huntsville with a Suburban full of boys making their way to marching band, mountain biking, Boy Scouts, 4H Club, Rifle Club and many other events.

When Jerry began her battle with cancer she did so courageously, selflessly, and privately. Along with the loving support and determination from Pete and Hunter as well as her family, she faced the challenges with hope and positivity. Her determination to see Hunter graduate from high school and move on to college was the driving force that compelled her to bravely meet these challenges. Jerry was a very determined and relentless fighter. In our hearts, she won that battle because today she is no longer in pain; "where o death is now thy sting?" Her faith and love in the Lord Jesus, in whom she believed, issued forth in private prayers to Him while she was with us. Now, from her eternal resting place with the Lord, we, her family, believe Jerry's heart is looking to all of us that we would look after her children. And, we, in response, are ever so humbled and honored to do. Thus, in Jerry's honor, our call is that all of the immediate and extended family, and friends, would all care for one another just as she would for us.

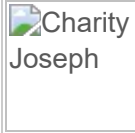
