Joe Cobbs, Jr., 88, of Huntsville, Texas passed away on January 7, 2018 in Huntsville, Texas. He was born on March 10, 1929 in Mt. Enterprise, Texas to Joe Cobbs, Sr. and Grace (Glascock) Cobbs.

Joe served in the military for 22 years. He flew B-29s and B-52s in the Korean Conflict. While in the military, Joe became a Professional Boxer and won the Washington State Champion two years in row. He then became a boxing coach. During his career he was a Baseball Coach, Boy Scout Leader, Volunteer Firefighter, and First Responder. He received Firefighter of the Year and First Responder of the Year. After he retired, he moved to Dodge with his family. He then worked and retired from the Post Office. He also went to college at the age of 40 and in four years received his Bachelor's Degree.

Joe was a deacon of First Baptist Church of Dodge.

Joe loved hunting and fishing and especially, gardening. He grew a two acre garden every year and supplied vegetables for the whole neighborhood.

Joe was married to his wife Jane for 66 years.

Joe is survived by son Tim Cobbs and his wife, Margaret; daughter Patti Dostal and her husband, Bubba; grandchildren Paul – Kevin Cobbs and wife

Lacey, Benny Cobbs and wife Christa, and Jenifer Koon; great-grandchildren Julia, Lyla, Kinley, Bowen and Crue; sister Camilla Risinger. He is preceded in death by his wife Jane Cobbs and parents.
