Joe MacAuthur McDaniel Joe MacAuthur McDaniel passed away on September 12, 2010. Born on April 17, 1942, in Baileyton, Alabama, Joe proudly served as a demolition and mine warfare specialist and a marksman instructor in the United States Marine Corp. from 1959 to 1963, and is a veteran of the Vietnam war. Joe was employed by N.L. Bariod for more than 15 years and owned and operated Weld-It Company for 24 years in Houston and Huntsville, TX. He is survived by his wife of 25 years, Evelyn Martin McDaniel, his children, Sheila and Michael McDaniel; siblings David McDaniel, Allen McDaniel, Margie Crowel and Kathy Mode. Joe was an instrumental force in the restoration of the San Jacinto School house in West Sandy, Walker County, Texas, a member of the Sons of the Confederate Veterans, and an avid contributor to the Walker County Historical Commission. Joe will be remembered for his kindness, generosity, strength of character and as a devoted husband and best friend to his wife, Evelyn. A memorial service will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 16, 2010, at First Christian Church, 1800 Avenue R, Huntsville, with Rev. Kyle Dennis officiating.
