John Hubert "Big John" Cameron passed away on August 23, 2004, in Huntsville, after a long courageous battle against cancer. Services will be held on August 26, 2004, at 6:00 p.m. at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home in Huntsville, Texas. Officiating will be Reverend Reagan M. Cooksey. John was born on August 19, 1941, in Groveton, Texas. He lived his early childhood in Oklahoma and East Texas. John moved to Huntsville in 1980. He retired as a criminal investigator from the U. S. Army in 1980, at the rank of Chief Warrant Officer II.
