



## John "Jack" Vanderlyn Moser

May 30, 1961 - April 23, 2024

John "Jack" Vanderlyn Moser passed away peacefully Tuesday, April 23, 2024, in Conroe, Texas while surrounded in prayer by his wife and two daughters. Jack was born on May 30, 1961 in Carlisle, Pennsylvania to Don Carl Moser and Helen Pike Moser. He was the youngest of four children.

Jack met his wife, Holly, at Purdue University and after graduation moved to Beaumont, Texas. Shortly after moving, Jack and Holly built their home in Sour Lake, Texas, where they raised their family for nearly 30 years. Other than being married to Holly, Jack's most proud accomplishment was being father to his two beautiful daughters, Amanda and Abigail, as well as 'Papa' to three grandchildren: Landon, Gwyneth, Sawyer and expecting his fourth at the end of May.

Employed as a civil engineer for the Texas Department of Transportation for over 25 years until his retirement, Jack then went on to work for the Diocese of Beaumont until 2019. A few years later, he and Holly moved to Montgomery, Texas.

Aside from family, some of Jack's greatest passions were his Catholic faith, his many travels to Hawaii and spending time with his friends. Never one for idleness, Jack loved working in the garden, playing tennis with Holly, golf with family/friends and helping his daughters with projects.

He is survived by his wife, Holly, his daughters, Amanda Miller and her husband Zack, Abigail Bogle and her husband Tucker, two sisters, Anne MacLachlan and her husband Bill, Katy Chekaluk and her husband Chris, and one brother, Ned Moser and his wife Kristine. Along with many nieces and nephews, Jack is also survived by his grandsons, Landon and Sawyer Miller and granddaughter Gwyneth Bogle.
