



## Dr. John E. Nesselrode

June 19, 1926 - January 12, 2007

Dr. John. E. Nesselrode was born on June 19, 1926 in Parkersburg, West Virginia and was called to his heavenly home in January 6, 2007. Although losing his battle with cancer, the memory of his zest for life will continue to live on. After graduating from Baylor College of Medicine, he opened his medical practice back in Baytown in 1953. He was doctor, counselor, and friend to much of Baytown for his 37 years in practice. His last 8 years of work were spent as a professor from UTMB, teaching family practice as the director of the Family Practice Residency Program at San Jacinto Methodist in Baytown. He retired to Crosby, Texas and became a gentleman farmer. His retirement years were full of hobbies, farm work, and family - but he never lost his love of helping people and teaching. So it was no surprise that he made the decision to donate his body to UTMB for continued instructional opportunities for medical students. Dr. John was preceded in death by his parents, Otho and Gladys Nesselrode, his wife Irene Nesselrode, his brother Jack Nesselrode, and his nephew Michael Nesselrode. He is survived by his children Lynn Kenney of Crosby, David and Laura Nesselrode of Huntsville, grandchildren Elizabeth and Ross Nesselrode of Huntsville, sister-in-law Barbara Nesselrode, niece Sheryl and husband Bill Adams, nephews, Greg Nesselrode and Brian Nesselrode and wife Patricia, and a host of extended family and friends. Dr. John was a long time member of First Baptist Church of Baytown, but due to health reasons, he had begun attending with his daughter at New Life Assembly in Houston. He found there a loving pastor and church

family and considered that his home church. The celebration service of his life will be held at New Life Assembly, 749 Uvalde, Houston, Texas at 11 AM, Friday, January 12, 2007. Pastor Darold DeHart of New Life and Bill Ingram of First Baptist Baytown will officiate the service. After the service, a coffee reception will be held at the church.
