Jorge was born in Tecpan Guatemala, to Laura C. Morales and Jorge M. Morales, on September 1st, 1974. He was the second oldest of six children. Jorge is preceded in death by his brother Mario A. Morales.

Jorge grew up in Camden, NJ along with the rest of his siblings and his parents. He graduated Pennsauken Vocational School and later moved to Texas where he opened his own business, George's Carpet Cleaning.

Jorge is survived by his wife of almost 21yrs, Dolores, 2 sons Mario and Omar and 2 Daughters Cynthia and Denisse. Jorge is also survived by his Mother and Father, one brother Luis Morales, three sisters Monica Estrada, Enma White, Carmen Morales, sister in-law Claudia Morales and countless loving nieces and nephews.

Jorge fought Leukemia for almost three years. He was first diagnosed in August 2017. He received countless amounts of treatments including two bone marrow transplants donated by his loving sister Monica. He fought a good fight and was one tough guy. He was always willing to push harder and endure the pain that these treatments brought without hesitation. He always

requested that his family do everything possible to help keep him alive. After having fought for so long he finally succumbed to his illness. We can find comfort in knowing that Jorge is no longer feeling any pain or suffering and he is now with God and our beloved brother Fito.

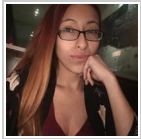
