Joseph “Joe” Lamar Grant was born June 27, 1993 in Houston, Texas to Glen and Dana Grant. Joe suddenly and unexpectedly walked into the loving arms of his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on December 14, 2018 in Minot, North Dakota at the age of 25. Joe was preceded in death by his paternal grandfather, Glen Grant, Sr. and maternal grandmother, Marylyn Seidel. Joe is survived by his parents, Glen and Dana Grant of Huntsville, Texas; his brother, Jimmy Grant of Galveston, Texas; paternal grandmother, Jessie Grant; maternal grandfather, Franklin Seidel; numerous aunts, uncles, cousins and friends.

He attended Huntsville schools and graduated from Huntsville High School in 2012. During his school years, Joe was active in Boy Scout Troop 114. He attained the highest rank in Scouting when he became an Eagle Scout in 2010. His love of scouting was shown as he worked at camps each summer as Quartermaster. He was a member of First United Methodist Church, Huntsville, Texas.

Joe graduated from Texas State Technical College in Waco, Texas in December 2014. He received an Associate of Applied Science degree in Building Construction Technology. While attending TSTC, he developed an interest in carpentry, specializing in custom cabinetry. His passion for woodworking turned his talent into a career.

As an independent craftsman, Joe’s gifts were evident in the many and varied projects into which he accepted. Always eager to learn, Joe was constantly on

the lookout for the next opportunity. He described himself as “Not your average Joe.” Joe’s kind heart and loving spirit was shown in the many ways he helped those he could. He had an astonishing ability to reach people in a profound and positive way. Joe will be greatly missed by everyone who knew him. He was the kind of young man that anyone would be proud to call son, grandson and friend.
