Joseph P. Oates, a Waterwood, TX resident since 1996, formerly of Houston, TX, passed away unexpectedly on Thursday, April 4, 2013. Joe was born on Long Island, New York on October 25, 1938. He is survived by his wife of 53 years, Kathleen. Joe was always very active in both his community and his church. Joe served his country as a submariner in the United States Navy from 1958 – 1966. Joe served on the Waterwood Improvement Association Board, the MUD Board, the Fire Department and was an officer in the Waterwood Security Force. He attended Saint Stephen the Martyr RC Church where he served as President of the Pastoral Council for 5 years, was an usher and also helped establish the Men's Club.
