Joseph and his family moved to Huntsville in 1991 where he had lived and attended school where he graduated from Huntsville High School in 2005 . He had wanted to follow his inclination in electronics and cinematography. He worked hard to save his money and pursue this goal in California but at a young age of 21, Joseph met with a tragic accident that cut his life short. He left behind a loving father, Ray, mother, Ronita, siblings, Roanne Marie and Jomar Ray, and lots of friends who enjoyed his humor and jokes. Joseph was respectfully, courteous and loving. He was also very helpful with his computer electronics skills. God decided that he was too good to stay on earth, so he took him home on Wednesday July 16, 2008.
