Kenneth Monroe Hardy was born in Robeline, Louisiana on November 21, 1937. Son of William Albert Hardy and Ruthie Marcelite Mitchell. He grew up in Many, Louisiana and attended Northwestern State College, where he met his sweetheart. He married Judy on April 23, 1956.
