Kenneth Schenk, surrounded by his family, entered fully into the presence of his Lord and Savior on April 24th, 2018 at the age of 77.

Born in Philadelphia to German immigrants, Ken, the youngest of three children, learned the trade of baking from his father. Working in a bakery was what he loved most, until he met Patricia Snyder and the two married and had three kids, Kenneth Jr, Kimberlea and Timothy. Ken owned Schenk's Pastry Shoppe in Mechanicsburg, PA for over 20 years.

Following their dad's footsteps, both sons learned the trade and opened bakeries of their own. Even after retirement, Ken could be found working at a bench at either sons' bakeries.

Ken is preceded in death by his parents and siblings. He is survived by his wife, Patricia, and their three children. He will be fondly remembered by his 9 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren.
