Lassiter E. "Bud" Gregg, 84, of Point Blank, Texas, passed away on December 19, 2012, in Oakhurst, Texas. He was born on January 6, 1928, in Houston, Texas, to Leslie Elmo Gregg and Amelia Mary Raif Gregg. Bud came to know the Lord Jesus at a very early age. He graduated from Livingston High School and from University of Maryland in Munich, Germany, with a degree in Business Administration.

He is preceded in death by his parents and brothers, L.V. Gregg and Donard Gregg. Bud is survived by his wife, Mildred "Milly" Counts Gregg; children, Lassister E. He was also an active member of the First Baptist Church in Onalaska and charter members of the Sagemont Baptist Church in Houston, Texas. He and Milly both were involved in "Singins" all over the state of Texas on a regular basis. Bud and Milly traveled the world at least 2-3 times a year.

Above all these things, Bud and Milly have always been proud of their family, treasuring the time spent with them.
