Lee R. Anzaldua Sr. aka “pawpaw” or “Tio Lee” (Uncle Lee) was born December 22nd 1955 in Robstown TX; the son of Emilio Anzaldua (deceased) & Adela Anzaldua. Brothers of David, Edward and sister Lillian Anzaldua.
