



## Leonard Singleton Jr.

January 26, 1938 - November 21, 2020

Leonard Singleton, Jr. passed away at his home in Baytown on November 21, 2020 at age 82, after a long battle with cancer. His wife of 52 years, Pauline, was at his side. He was born in Montgomery County, Texas, to Leonard Singleton, Sr. and Virgie Mae (Polly) Smith Singleton. He was preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Alton Glenn Singleton. In addition to his wife, he is survived by his sisters Katie Francis and Barbara Paul, sister-in-law Brenda Singleton, and by numerous nieces and nephews.

Leonard graduated from Montgomery High School in 1956, and then served his country in the U. S. Army. Upon his return to civilian life, he went to work for Diamond Alkali (later Diamond Shamrock and finally Occidental Chemical Corp). He retired after 39 years in operations.

His heart remained on the farm. Throughout his life, his spare time was devoted to raising cattle, training horses, shoeing horses, baling hay and helping friends.
