Lillian Maxine (Bowers) Triplett, 85 of Huntsville, Texas in Walker County, passed away peacefully on November 26, 2015.

Maxine was born in Moscow, Idaho on November 10, 1930. She was the youngest of 9 children born to Edgar Alexander Bowers and Susie Jane (Rea) Bowers. She grew up on an apple orchard in the Boise, Idaho area.
