



Judge Lloyd Neal Roark, Sr

December 14, 1942 - April 28, 2016

Lloyd Neal Roark, age 73, of Dodge, TX, passed away on April 28, 2016, surrounded by his loving family. He was born in Huntsville, Texas, on December 14, 1942. He was preceded in death by his parents, Marshall and Lillian Roark; brother, Gene Baker; and grandson, Marshall Will Roark. He is survived by his devoted wife of 51 years, Mary; son, Lloyd, Jr. and wife Lori, grandchildren, Lacey, Kari and Haley; sister, Mary Ann Gladden and husband David; sister, Lou Nell Husfeld and husband Delbert; sister-in-law, Barbara Locke and husband Bobby; brother in law Billy Currie; sister -in-law, Gwynetta Baker, along with numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.

Lloyd started school in Dodge and graduated from Huntsville High School in 1962. In 1963 Lloyd opened his first store in Dodge. Shortly after, he was drafted into the military. In 1965, he married the love of his life. Lloyd and Mary re-opened Lloyd's Store and they remained in business until 1979. In 1979, Lloyd was elected Justice of the Peace, Precinct 3. During his 32 year tenure, he enjoyed helping the public and was known for his "open door" policy. He was a mentor for fellow Judges and served on numerous boards and committees.

Lloyd enjoyed bus trips to Louisiana, riding his four wheeler, feeding his fish and birds, going to sprint car races, hunting and fishing, raking his hayfields, working outdoors, and spending time with the apple of his eye; his

granddaughter Lacey.
