She also sang in Carnegie Hall with a select group of singers in Nov 1992. Jeanne really believed in Christ's commandment to love one another as well as yourself. She continued to care for others long after her formal nursing career ended. Her proudest achievements in life were her children. Melinda Zuber, York Zuber and wife Wendy, Amy Zuber Brigham and husband Randy Brigham; Granddaughter, Ryan Elise Brigham and Grandson Justin Edward Brigham. She leaves behind her brother, Paul D Davis, numerous cousins and a host of friends.
